Tulane University is committed to education in our state of Louisiana. To show our commitment to our state and to your students, we created the *Focus Louisiana* program, which consists of admission and financial aid initiatives designed to encourage our Louisiana high school students to investigate Tulane as a college choice. As part of the program, we host *Louisiana Campus Preview Days*, a chance for high school *juniors and sophomores* to spend a day on Tulane's campus exploring the academic, cultural, and social opportunities that have always been and will continue to be available at Tulane University and in New Orleans.

The program will take place **Monday, February 15, Wednesday, February 17, and Friday, February 19**. Students should choose *one day* out of this week to visit. The program will begin at 8:35 a.m. on the second floor of the Lavin-Bernick Center for University Life, and the schedule will include the following events:

- Financial Aid Session
- Class Visits (optional)

Most students attend the program with one or both parents. Students should **submit their RSVPs by Monday, February 8**, to ensure receipt of an itinerary, driving directions, and parking information before their arrival.

Due to the increased popularity of the program and space constraints, we cannot accommodate large school groups; however, we welcome you to bring a group of students for a visit during another time.
